Additionally, he or she will support the Community Hatchery Program (CHP), ALUS Peterborough, Invasive Species Awareness Program (ISAP), and Lake Ontario Atlantic Salmon Restoration Program (LOASRP) with outreach efforts and field work (fish stocking, youth engagement, and invasive species monitoring).
